Dear CPS Families & Community,

I am writing to share some updates and information about Statewide Assessments that students in Grades 3-10 take each year in the Spring. For 18 years, CPS students have taken a pencil-and-paper test called MCAS (Massachusetts Comprehensive Assessment System) during the Spring semester. The following Fall, families received a report indicating whether their student's test scores met grade-level expectations. The State also used this assessment to help school districts identify groups of students who need more or different types of support to be successful.

Over the next two years, all Massachusetts public schools will transition to a computerized assessment, which is informally known as MCAS 2.0. Still in development, MCAS 2.0 is based on a nationally-developed assessment called PARCC (Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Career).

MCAS 2.0 will not be ready for implementation until Spring 2017. To prepare for the transition, school districts were given a choice of whether to administer the old MCAS this year, or to administer PARCC. The Cambridge School Committee has voted to administer PARCC this year, to better prepare our students to take MCAS 2.0 in 2017.

On the reverse of this letter is the Spring 2016 assessment schedule, including which schools are taking PARCC via computer, and which have chosen to remain with a pencil-and-paper option for one more year.
